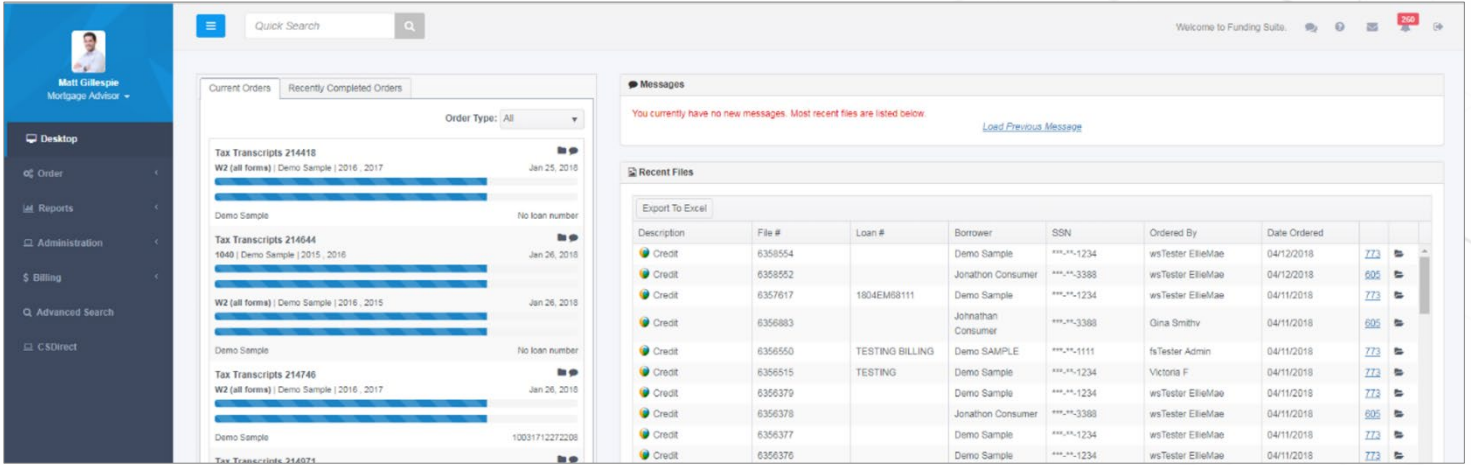


The **Desktop** manages and organizes each users current and recent working files. This intelligent display allows immediate access to credit files with a single mouse click while displaying current order statuses.

The following pending product orders are displayed under Current Orders:

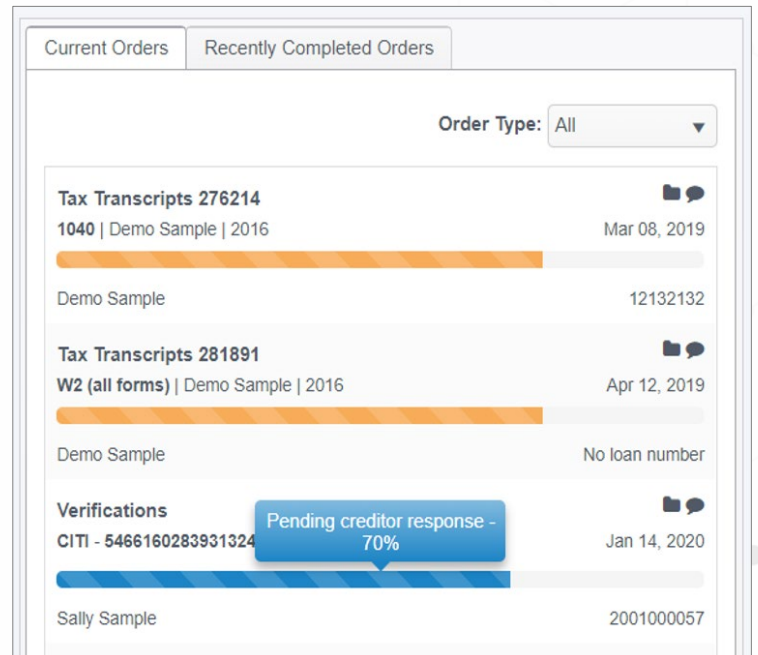
- Supplements (Inquiry, VOE, NTC)

Quickly post message to support by clicking quote icon.

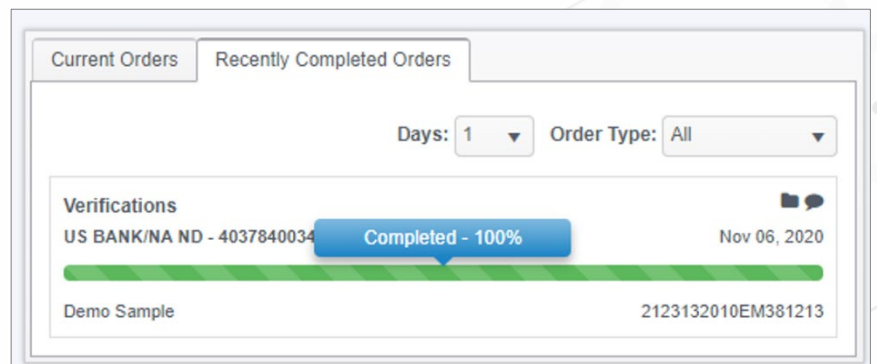


Recently Completed Orders
